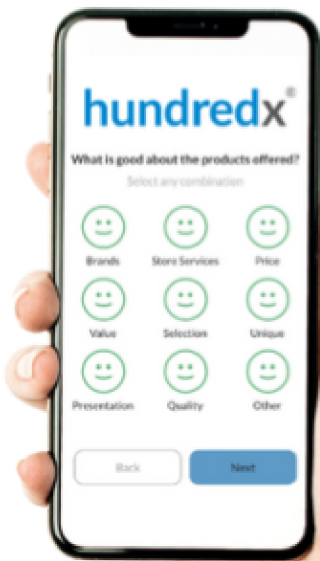
1. Text "IMPACT" to 90412 to sign up or use the QR code

To be eligible for any office you must be a member in good standing, and have been a member for at least 12 months for Officer positions, and 6 months for Director positions.

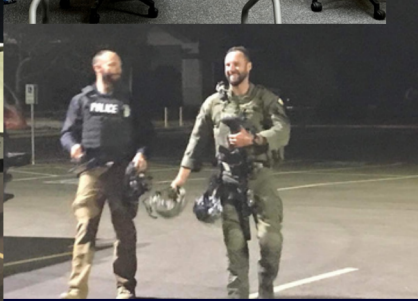
